

Errata in R20 Regulations

B. Tech: The following sections are to be read as under.

5.2: * A relaxation of 10% of maximum marks shall be given to physically challenged students

5.2.2 b: Before the end of instruction, a Skill Test will be conducted for 20 marks. The practical semester end examination shall be conducted with an examiner along with the lab faculty. The examiner shall be appointed by the Dean (Examinations) of the University

5.6 d: If the difference of the final marks after revaluation is greater than or equal to 15 % of maximum marks, then the revaluation marks are considered for declaring the result.

B. Pharm: The following is an additional item under the main section 5.

5.2.6: Industrial Training: The candidates have to undergo Industrial Training for one month (Minimum 200 Hrs.) during the vacation after III Yr. II Sem. Examination. The certificate of the Training should be submitted to the Head of the Department. There shall be no marks for Industrial Training.


M.B.A: The following section is to be read as under.

4.44: For all laboratory courses, there shall be CIE during a semester for 50 marks and SEE for 50 marks. Out of the 50 marks for CIE, the breakup shall be as follows:

1)	Preparation for Lab :	10 marks
2)	Observation :	10 marks
3)	Completion of Experiment / Programming / Exercise:	5 marks
4)	Record :	5 marks
5)	Skill Test :	20 marks
