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PLAN OF ACTIONS FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21

1. To motivate faculty, staff and students to put their best efforts to bring out the ambience and standards to the level of University after the proposed transformation of the existing Anurag Group of Institutions to Anurag University. Senior faculty may have the opportunity to take part in the framing of statutes of the University for its proper and efficient functionality.
2. Curriculum development : To develop best possible curriculum with the involvement of all the internal faculty of Departments and having academic and industry experts in the respective Board of Studies from premier educational Institutions like IITS, Central and State Universities, Research laboratories and experts from relevant Industries and also prominent alumni as members of their boards.
3. Introduction of new courses and programs to suit the needs of the Industry and Society: As University and having more freedom to introduce interdisciplinary courses in all the programs of both UG and PG and more in the form of electives to the choice of students. To start new UG and PG programs having industry and society relevance in Engineering, Pharmacy and Management areas.
4. After transformation into University, may think of to start UG programs in Agriculture, Basic Science, Arts and Commerce to widen the scope of the University.
5. To introduce Honors and Minor degrees in all Engineering UG programs to provide independent knowledge in a specialized area of their discipline and to provide basic knowledge in important areas of their discipline as per the student's choice and eligibility as per AICTE guidelines.
6. To introduce Ph.D. programs and make admissions as per UGC guidelines in Engineering, Management , Pharmacy, Humanities and basic Sciences and improve Laboratory and computational facilities to promote quality research leading to good Journal Publications and Patents.
7. Encourage faculty members possessing Doctoral Degrees to apply Research/ Sponsored/ consultancy projects to strengthen the laboratories further and promote research culture

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among the faculty undergoing Ph.D. programs and research scholars allotted into University and PG/UG students.

8. To encourage faculty members to conduct/attend more National / International conferences, workshops, FDPs to share their research funding /enhance their knowledge levels.
9. To sign more number of MoUs with Tier-1 industries interaction between industry and academia, to bring placements, industry oriented consultancies, to organize training program for students and staff under Institute Industry Interaction (III) cell. The coordinator of III cell is advised to work along with TLC, placement cell and R&D cell to initiate the above activities. The TLC, Placement cell and R&D cell are advised to cooperate with III cell.
10. To strengthen the staff and students to participate in outreach and sports activities. The IQAC appreciated the efforts that are kept by NSS and Physical director's team, however asked to strengthen these activities further to create more awareness. All heads of the departments are advised to coordinate and cooperate with NSS and PDS to enrich these activities.
