**Item 3:** Approval of the amendment of the course structure of the 2nd and 3rd year B. Tech CSE and B.Tech CSE - Data Science to balance the teaching load:

- a) In 2nd year B.Tech CSE, Swapping for Design Thinking course (1 credit) with Soft skills Lab course (1 credit)
- b) In 3rd year B.Tech CSE, Verbal ability and critical reasoning will be offered in place of Skill Integrated Language Lab of 1.5 credits.

- c) In 3rd year B.Tech CSE-Data Science, Swapping of Skill Integrated Language Lab with Verbal ability and critical reasoning and vice-versa.

**Item 3 c.** Resolved to approve the amendment of reorganization of the 3<sup>rd</sup> year B.Tech (Computer Science and Engineering-Data Science) course structure to balance the teaching load.

Skill Integrated Language Lab is swapped with Verbal Ability and Critical Reasoning in 3<sup>rd</sup> year B. Tech (Computer Science and Engineering-Data Science) w.e.f. AY 2023-24.

**Item 4:** Amendment of Item 5.4 of the B.Tech (R22) Academic Regulations with reference to transfer of students admitted into B.Tech programs and substitute courses for readmitted students.

In view of the students admitted through transfer or readmission in to various B. Tech programs, a few substitute courses are offered to them in order to comply with the academic requirements of the Anurag University for the award of the degree.

It is proposed to offer the substitute courses by doing away with the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) component, as the number of such students are very limited.

The performance of a student in a semester shall be evaluated course-wise for a maximum of 100 marks in each theory and practical course.

The semester end theory and practical examinations shall be conducted for 100 marks for the duration of 180 minutes. The theory examination paper shall have Part-A for 30

marks and Part- B for 70 marks. The practical examination shall be conducted for 100 marks in which the distribution of marks is as follows:

- a. Preparation for Lab – 5 marks
- b. Observation – 10 marks
- c. Completion of two Experiments – 25 marks each i.e., 50 Marks
- d. Record – 10 marks
- e. Viva- 25 marks.

**Resolution 4:**

It is resolved to approve the amendment of item 5.4 of the B.Tech (R22) Academic Regulations with reference to transfer of students into B.Tech programs and substitute courses offered for readmitted students.

**Item 5:** Amendment of the credits and course category of the Quantitative Aptitude course of the 2nd semester MCA (R22).

The evaluation (CIE and SEE) for the Quantitative Aptitude course is conducted on an online platform in which students have to solve objective type of questions. As there is a change in evaluation, it is proposed to change the category of Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning course from BS to BS Lab with a change in number of lecture and practical hours. No. of Lecture hours are revised to 1 and practical hours to 2. However, there is no change in number of credits.

The members of the council in its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting have suggested to relook into total number of credits offered at each semester keeping in view the guidelines of AICTE, CBCS and NCrF.

**Item 6 a:** It is proposed to revise the total credits of MBA (R22) program from 112 to 102. The item 5.10 of the academic regulations of MBA (R22) is amended as follows:

The item 8.2 of the academic regulations of MBA (R22) is amended as follows:

**Item 7a:** Amendment of Assessment mechanism of Programming and Problem Solving - I course offered in Electrical and Electronics Engg., Civil Engg., and Mechanical Engg., for the AY 2023-24.

Prof S. Madhu, Director, Anurag Centre for Educational – Innovations (ACE), explained the background for the amendment in the assessment in respect of some subjects.

Anurag University has entered into agreement with Aalborg University, Denmark under which the later has agreed to provide PBL training for the faculty members of Anurag University. Accordingly, Renewable Energy Technologies course for B.Tech III year I Sem EEE students (AY 2023-24), Signals and Systems course for B.Tech II Year I Sem ECE students (AY 2023-24) and Programming for Problem Solving – I (PPS-I) course for B.Tech I year students (AY 2023-24) are selected, and the respective faculty have been trained. Out of the three courses opted, first two have been already implemented with training being given to the respective faculty with the approval of the 9th Academic Council. Further, it is requested to implement PPS-I for EEE, Civil and Mechanical Engineering I year students.

**Resolution 7a:**

It is resolved to approve the amendment of assessment mechanism of course “Programming and Problem Solving – I” offered in Electrical and Electronics Engg., Civil Engg., and Mechanical Engg., for the AY 2023-24.

The Chancellor has suggested to implement assessment scheme of 60:40 for all the courses of B.Tech. programs run by the School of Engineering.
