Item 8: Fee Fixation and seat matrix of MBBS program in Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences, revision of fee structure for B.Tech. programs, revised intake in existing programs and starting of new programs.

a. Fee Fixation and seat matrix of MBBS program in Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences, Anurag University, Hyderabad.

Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences of Anurag University has been granted approval by National Medical Commission (NMC) for 150 MBBS seats for the academic year 2023-24.

After detailed discussion it is decided the following seat matrix:

General Category (85%)	128
NRI / in lieu of NRI (15%)	22

As per Section 33 of Telangana State Private Universities Act 11 of 2018, 25% of seats for admissions in the courses undertaken by Anurag University shall be exclusively reserved for the students of the state of Telangana on the basis of domicile as may be prescribed.

The number of domicile reserved seats are 38 (out of 150).

As per GO Ms. No: 26, dated 20.08.2019 in Rule 10 the prescribed domicile reservation is as follows:

- 25% of seats for admissions in all the faculties / courses undertaken by university shall be

- ii. Children whose parent / parents born or worked at least for two years in the state of Telangana shall be treated as students of Telangana for this purpose.

Fee Structure:

Considering the above seat matrix taking into consideration of the income and expenditure as per NMC guidelines, the recommendations of the fee fixation committee for MBBS course for the block period of three years from 2023-24 to 2025-26 of the Anurag University are as follows:

- **General Category seat:** 15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) per annum per student.
- **NRI / in lieu of NRI seat:** 22,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Fifty Thousands only) per annum per student.

Resolution: "Resolved to accept the recommendations of the Fee Fixation Committee related to MBBS course tuition fee per annum for General category seat is Rs. 15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) and NRI / in lieu of NRI seat Rs. 22,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Fifty Thousands only)".

b. Fee structure for B.Tech. programs of Anurag University other than admissions from Convenor, EAMCET.

After reviewing the statements of income and expenditure of B.Tech. programs of the University for the last three academic years from 2020-21 to 2022-23, the fee fixation committee has recommended an increase of 14% for the block period three years from 2023-24 to 2025-26.

Resolution: It is resolved that the Fee Fixation Committee recommendations of an increase of 14% for block period 2023-24 to 2025-26 are mentioned for below courses.
