The Chairman, GECT, Dr Palla Rajeshwar Reddy welcomed the members to the First Board of Management Meeting of Anurag University. He also gave the background of AGI and the setting up of

Anurag University as a Brown Field University. The Vice Chancellor, Prof S Ramachandram, conducted the proceedings of the meeting by taking up the items on the agenda

Item 1: Minutes of the Meeting of the First Academic Council and Approval of Intake for the School of Engineering (2020–2021)

Resolution 1: It was unanimously resolved to approve the Minutes of the Meeting of the First Academic Council. Further, the total intake of the School of Engineering was approved at 1440 (UG) and 156 (PG) for the year 2020-21 (Annexure 1).

Item2: Suggestions / Recommendations for the promotion of Anurag University

Resolution 2: The following suggestions and recommendations made by the eminent persons namely Mr. Lingireddy Ramakrishna Reddy, Dr.Vishnubhotla Naga Prasad, Dr.M.V. Krishna Murthy and Dr.U. Balaji, for the promotion of Anurag University, were noted for further action:

- a. Formation of Schools instead of Departments and setting up of committees for revising the curriculum which is current, inter disciplinary and job oriented.
- b. Health care has gained prominence in India and M.Pharm. (Pharmaceutical Analysis and Quality Assurance) will have great demand. Student's awareness to such needs/opportunities should be enhanced by organizing talks and collaborating with industry for internships. Further a "PG Diploma in Pharmacy and Quality Assurance" can be planned in collaboration with Aurobindo Formulation.
- c. Introduce Honors degree in BTech, BPharm and BBA programs and work out the details for its implementation
- d. Identify programs which can be strengthened and can become the forte of Anurag University. These will enable branding of the University
- e. Concentrate on R&D and set up an Incubation Centre, so as to enable multidisciplinary work to be carried out
- f. Work towards making the University self-sustainable

Item 3: Vision, Mission, Core Values

The members deliberated on the Vision, Mission and Core Values of Anurag University and offered following suggestions on formulating the Mission:

- Identify a 3 to 5 year time line for achieving the mission
- Identify specific goals to be achieved during this timeline, like improving NIRF ranking, placements etc.,
- Metrics should also be devised to assess the achievement of the mission

Regarding core values, it was suggested to reduce number to three or four. Prof Mutha Reddy related events in support of core values at AGI. The members suggested that such events/stories be documented. Dr Vishnu Murthy gave an account of the achievements of the students. The prominent and latest one, was the winning of two teams of AGI, at the software edition of Smart India Hackathon 2020, held between 1-8-2020 to 03-08-2020 and receiving a cash award of Rs 1 lakh each

Resolution 3: It was resolved to

- Accept the Vision
- To place the Vision, Mission, Core Values on the website of Anurag University and elicit inputs from various stakeholders of Anurag University
