Sub: AGI-Adding Grace Marks for the students of R15 Regulations -
Approved Orders - Issued.

Ref: Resolution under Item no.3 in the minutes of the Governing
Body meeting held on 20-2-2019.

ORDER:

As per R12 Academic Regulations of Anurag Group of Institutions (AGI), the student is awarded grace marks not exceeding 0.15% marks of the total marks to one or two failed subjects provided adding these grace marks helps the student to pass in one or two failed subjects and get eligibility to receive the degree by submitting an application cum undertaking.

The AGI introduced Choice – Based Credit System (CBCS) with effect from the Academic Year 2015-16 as R15 Academic Regulations. As per CBCS, only the letter grade and grade point average are shown in the marks memo of the student; the actual marks secured by the student are not shown and the student has to pass all the subjects.

However, the JNTUH vide proceeding No. A1/2557/XXXVIII SCAS/2018(5), Dated: 30-08-2018 has considered and approved the award of grace marks for CBCS scheme of students. Several Students and their Parents of AGI have represented to extend the same benefit to the students of R15 Academic Regulations of AGI.

In view of the above, the matter was placed before the Governing Body meeting held on 20-2-2019.

The Governing Body approved to adopt the same as per the Proceeding No. A1/2557/XXXVIII SCAS/2018(5), Dated: 30-08-2018 issued by JNTUH. Under the circumstances as stated above, the awarded marks will be considered as per the details given below:

- i) After declaration of every final series of examinations (UG & PG) the list of all the eligible students will be notified by the examination branch.
- ii) The benefit of grace marks shall be extended only to students who submit their application cum undertaking after notification.

This will be implemented with effect from R15 Academic Regulations of AGI.

Sub: Concessions granted to Physically Challenged (PHC) students of AGI - Orders Issued.

ORDER:

With reference to the proceedings cited above, the governing body at its meeting held on 20th February 2019, approved the following concessions to the physically challenged students admitted in UG & PG courses of AGI.

1. Exemption from payment of Examination Fees by Deaf and Dumb, orthopedically handicapped and visually challenged students admitted in all courses.
2. Reduction of Pass Marks, in each subject by 10% for Deaf and Dumb orthopedically handicapped and visually challenged students of all courses.
3. a) The facility of (i) providing a scribe and (ii) Twenty Minutes of compensatory time for each hour of examination is to be provided to all physically challenged candidates, if i) the student is with 40% or more disability and ii) have necessity to use a scribe to write the examinations as per reference (2). This facility is provided to the students admitted into all courses of the AGI.
b) Physically Challenged students, who are not making use of a scribe are also eligible for "Compensatory Time" as given in point (a) above.
c) In case, any of the students admitted in other than physically challenged quota and becomes handicapped due to any type of accident, he/she may be provided similar benefit of using a scribe on production of "Medical Certificate" from competent authority. The student shall submit such certificates to the concerned authorities of the college.

Sub: AGI-Examinations – Fixing the number of attempts for writing supplementary examinations –approval orders-Issued.

Ref: Resolution approved under Item No.3 in the minutes of Governing Body Meeting held on 20-2-2019.

ORDER:

As per AGI Academic Regulations, the students (UG & PG) are allowed to write supplementary examinations in the failed subjects to complete their course within double the duration period of the course with the syllabus studied during his/her regular course of study.

The Governing Body at its meeting held on 20th February 2019, decided to conduct supplementary examinations in the failed subjects for a maximum of five times in addition to one regular examination (total six times). If the student is unable to clear the subject/s in six attempts (One Regular + five Subsequent Supplementary Examinations held), he/she shall have to appear for the examination with the syllabus of equivalent subjects prevailing for the regular students in that academic year. However, if no subject with similar title is offered in the current regulations, the examinations shall be conducted in the failed subject with the same syllabus, which the student studied during regular course of study with extra fees as fixed by the institute from time to time.

This will be implemented with effect from the examinations scheduled in the Academic Year 2019-20.
